#### ***Outcomes Identification and Systems Thinking***

Tuesday August 16, 9:00am to 4:00pm and Wednesday August 17, 9:00am to 4:00pm

Ensuring School readiness requires a comprehensive formula where systems are integrated at the intersection of enlightenment and accountability. "Systems Thinking" creates the critical foundation where paths to success become clearer. Quantifying progress toward identified targets can ensure that the system driving your services is high-quality. Linking results can help to identify patterns and trends where school readiness shines. By connecting these dots, participants will see how their services can inform one another and frame the bigger picture – SCHOOL READINESS. In order to sustain the gain, grantees and delegates must intentionally allocate resources to improve delivery of services in all areas.

During this two-day interactive workshop, participants will map their own evaluative measures to the Head Start Program Measures. Aggregating results and establishing targets will lead to discussion of data-driven decision making and the use of technology. The analysis and interpretation of results will guide participants towards correlating data and identifying patterns and trends. Program improvement Plans will be introduced as intentional strategies to make continuous improvements. Lastly, the cultural implications of an agency-wide outcomes based approach will be embedded within each segment.

#### ***Executive Function***

Thursday August 18, 9:00am to 4:00pm

In this workshop, participants will learn how supporting *executive functioning* in children can promote the development of learning in several domain elements as described by the Head Start Child Development and Early Learning Framework. The Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) will be shared as means to evaluate a teacher's ability to support the development of *executive functioning* in his/her children. Documenting the process of children's learning will highlight the domain elements closely related to executive function as well as the national STEM initiative.
